

CORNERSTONE OF NEW CHURCH WILL BE PLACED TOMORROW



St. Luke's Reformed Church as it Will Appear When Completed.

The congregation of St. Luke's Reformed Church has made elaborate preparations for the laying of the cornerstone of its new church building at North Main and Courtright avenue. The ceremonies will take place tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock.

The pastor of the church is Rev. H. A. Shiffer and with his congregation has worshipped in a small frame edifice on North Franklin street, which has become inadequate to the needs of the growing congregation. A plot of ground was accordingly secured on North Main street, at the location mentioned, where a handsome new brownstone church is being installed. The building of this church is requiring many sacrifices on the part of the congregation as it is a big expenditure, but from all indications in due course of time the obligations will be met and the congregation will have a fine church property, in a fine location, which will meet all requirements for some time to come.

The program that will be carried out at the ceremonies tomorrow will be as follows: Selection, choir; invocation, Rev. Victor A. Ruth; responsive reading, Rev. R. F. Kilne; greetings, Rev. Homer S. May, D. D.; address, Rev. James M. Mullan, superintendent of the Department of the East; selection, choir; offering; depositing of articles in the cornerstone; laying of cornerstone; prayer, Rev. A. D. Decker; trumpet trio led by R. W. Drumtra; doxology; benediction.
